Using a prior budget, estimate-at-completion, forecast-at-completion, or actual amounts as a starting point, build a new budget with the same or similar structure, revenue, and expenses. Then apply multipliers to scale the budget and modify the data to fit the current project.

Easily build budgets from estimates by importing or exporting information from external sources such as Microsoft® Excel or estimating applications.
